Genesis 22:1-14

Jehovah Jireh is . . .

1. The Lord who sees.
2. The Lord who provides.
3. The Lord who appears.

A. The Lord Who Sees

1. II Chr 16:9 He sees our need.
 - a. The eyes of the Lord run to and fro throughout the whole earth to show himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is willing toward him.
 - b. Strong = wealth
 - c. God has a covenant determination and passion to find us, prosper us and see to it that our need is met.
2. (HEB) God will see to it that it is done.
3. What God has provided by His grace, we must possess with our faith.
 - a. Rom 5:1-2 Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: by whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.
4. Mk 2:4-5 God sees our faith.
 - a. When they could not come nigh unto him for the press, they uncovered the roof where he was: and when they had broken it up, they let down the bed wherein the sick of the palsy lay. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the sick of palsy, "Son, thy sins be forgiven thee."
5. He sees our need and our faith.

B. The Lord Who Provides

1. Gen 22:14 (CEV) Abraham named that place, "The Lord Will Provide." And even now people say, "On the mountain of the Lord, it will be provided."
2. Lev 26:4, 5, 9, 10 (AMP) I will give you rain in due season, and the land shall yield her increase and the trees of the field yield their fruit. And your threshing [time] shall reach to the vintage and the vintage [time] shall reach to the sowing time, and you shall eat your bread to the full and dwell in your land securely. For I will be leaning toward you with favor and regard for you, rendering you fruitful, multiplying you, and establishing and ratifying My covenant with you. And you shall eat the [abundant] old store of produce long kept, and clear out the old [to make room] for the new.
 - a. Vs 10 (NLT) You will have such a surplus of crops that you will need to get rid of the leftovers from the previous year to make room for each new harvest.
 - b. Vs 10 (NIV) You will still be eating last year's harvest when you will have to move it out to make room for the new.

3. Deut 28:8, 11-12 (AMP) The Lord shall command the blessing upon you in your storehouse (KJV, storehouses) and in all that you undertake. And He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you. And the Lord shall make you have a surplus of prosperity, through the fruit of your body, of your livestock, and of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you. The Lord shall open to you His good treasury, the heavens, to give the rain of your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hands; and you shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.
4. I Sam 2:8 (AMP) He raises up the poor out of the dust and lifts up the needy from the ash heap, to make them sit with nobles and inherit the throne of glory. For the pillars of the earth are the Lord's, and He has set the world upon them.
5. Ps 23:1, 5 (AMP) The Lord is my Shepherd [to feed, guide, and shield me], I shall not lack. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my [brimming] cup runs over.
6. Ps 34:10 (AMP) The young lions lack food and suffer hunger, but they who seek (inquire of and require) the Lord [by right of their need and on the authority of His Word], none of them shall lack any beneficial thing.
7. Ps 36:7-9 (AMP) How precious is Your steadfast love, O God! The children of men take refuge and put their trust under the shadow of Your wings. They relish and feast on the abundance of Your house; and You cause them to drink of the stream of Your pleasures. For with You is the fountain of life; in Your light do we see light.
8. Ps 66:12 (KJV) Thou hast caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water: but thou broughtest us out into a wealthy place.
9. Ps 68:19 (KJV) Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah.
 - a. Ps 103:2 (AMP) Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul; and forget not [one of] all His benefits.
10. Ps 85:12 (AMP) Yes, the Lord will give what is good, and our land will yield its increase.
11. Ps 115:14-15 (KJV) The Lord shall increase you more and more, you and your children. Ye are blessed of the Lord which made heaven and earth.
12. Mal 3:10 (AMP) Bring all the tithes (the whole tenth of your income) into the storehouse, that there may be food in My house, and prove Me now by it, says the Lord of hosts, if I will not open the windows of heaven for you and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.
13. II Cor 9:8-12 (AMP) And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and furnished in abundance for every good work and charitable donation]. As it is written, He [the benevolent person] scatters abroad; He gives to the poor; His deeds of justice and goodness and kindness and benevolence will go on and endure forever! And [God] Who provides seed for the sower and bread for eating will also provide and multiply your [resources for] sowing and increase the fruits of your righteousness [which manifests itself in active goodness, kindness, and charity]. Thus you will be enriched in all things and in every way, so that you can be generous, and [your generosity as it is] administered by us will bring forth thanksgiving to God. For the service that the ministering of this fund renders does not only fully supply what is lacking to the saints (God's people), but it also overflows in many [cries of] thanksgiving to God.
14. II Pet 1:3 (KJV) According as his divine power hath given unto us all things

that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue.

C. The Lord Who Appears

1. Gen 22:14 (Brenton) And Abram called the name of that place, “The Lord had seen,” that they might say today, “In the mount, the Lord was seen.”
2. “Mount Moriah” defined
 - a. The mountain where Jehovah appears
 - b. The shown of Jehovah
 - c. The manifestation of Jehovah
 - d. Seen of Yah
3. When God appears, so does His provision.
 - a. John 11:40 (AMP) Jesus said to her, Did I not tell you and promise you that if you would believe and rely on Me, you would see the glory of God?
 - b. The glory of God—the presence of God heavy with everything good.
4. II Chr 1:7-12 God brought His supply when He appeared.
 - a. Vs 7 (AMP) That night God appeared to Solomon and said to him, Ask what I shall give you.
 - b. Vs 12 (AMP) Wisdom and knowledge are granted you. And I will give you riches, possessions, honor, and glory, such as none of the kings had before you, and none after you shall have their equal.
5. In the greatest of difficulties and impossibilities—when human assistance is just not enough—Jehovah Jireh will provide an overflowing and overwhelming supply for those who will believe and receive His supernatural provision.
