

## Supernatural Provision

### A. Phil 4:19 (AMP) My God Will Liberally Supply—Fill to Full—Your Every Need According to His riches in Glory in Christ Jesus

1. Word from the Lord
2. God has unlimited avenues and unusual ways to provide that are beyond our natural comprehension.
3. When it seems the most unlikely and impossible—when paycheck, economy, job market and others say, “This is humanly impossible”—God says, “I have ways to supernaturally provide for you.”
4. Enlarge our capacity to believe for and receive supernatural provision.
5. Renew our minds and open our hearts to think supernatural provision.

#### Notes: Greek Study of Phil 4:19

1. Supply – Cram, fill up, furnish, satisfy, finish, complete. “I am full.”
2. Need – Employment, requirements, lack, business
3. Riches – Wealth, money, possessions
4. Glory – Presence heavy with everything good
5. My God shall satisfy to the full all you need in accordance with His wealth in glory in Christ Jesus.

### B. Eph 3:20 (AMP) Now to Him Who, By the Action of His Power That Is at Work Within Us, Is Able to Carry Out His Purpose and Do Superabundantly, Far Over and Above All That We Dare Ask or Think Infinitely Beyond Our Highest Prayers, Desires, Thoughts, Hopes Or Dreams.

1. Super – Over, above, beyond, higher
  - a. Isa 55:6-9 God’s thoughts and ways are higher.
  - b. Ps 25:4 Show me your ways.
2. Natural – Lower, inferior, limited to the earthly realm
  - a. I Cor 2:14 The natural man receives not the things of the Spirit of God; for they are foolishness to him. Neither can he know them because they are spiritually discerned.
3. Supernatural – Whatever is from above, from a higher place in a higher way, not limited to this earthly realm or system.
4. Provision – A full supply, surplus, more than enough to meet the need.
5. Supernatural Provision – A full supply from above.
  - a. It comes from a higher place in a higher way above this earthly realm or system.
  - b. James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect (complete) gift is from above and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variableness neither shadow of turning.
  - c. Unlimited, accelerated, miraculous supply

Notes: Greek study of Eph 3:20

1. Exceedingly abundantly above
  - a. One Greek word
  - b. HYPER EK PERISSOU
    - i. Hyper – above, beyond, superior
    - ii. EK – out of
    - iii. PERISSOU – more than sufficient
  - c. Supply from above
2. Superabundantly beyond
3. Quite beyond all measure
4. Infinitely more than
5. Beyond what is normal or regular
6. Without limit
7. Then some on top of that
8. Super abundance
9. Think – exercise the mind
10. Now to the One who is able to do beyond all things, superabundantly beyond and over and above those things that we are asking for ourselves and considering in the measure of the power which is operative in us.

C. Rom 12:1-3 Renewing Our Minds

1. We must renew our mind to enlarge your capacity to receive.
2. The only thing that limits God from supplying is our limit on believing.
3. Vs 2 (AMP) Do not be confirmed to this world—this age, fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs. But be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind—by its new ideals and its new attitude—so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you].
  - a. Vs 3 Think according to faith.
4. Mark 9:23 If you can believe (for God’s supernatural provision) all things are possible.
5. Three things you can do to enlarge your capacity and take the limits off of God’s supernatural provision.
  - a. Read “supernatural provision” scriptures
    - i. Gen 22:6-14
    - ii. I Kings 17:1-16
    - iii. John 6:5-14
    - iv. Deut 28:1-4
    - v. These scriptures will paint a picture and an image on your heart of how you should be living.
  - b. Meditate
    - i. Apply – “This works for me.”
    - ii. Absorb
    - iii. Build into your spirit
  - c. Release faith for supernatural provision
    - i. I believe I receive supernatural provision.
