God's Prophetic Timeline

After Noah's flood, there were 70 nations on the earth. God chose to entrust His law and His treasures to one nation, the nation of Israel. He created and chose Israel for the purpose of blessing all the nations on earth.

The birth of the modern nation of Israel in 1948 demonstrates that God's promises are true. He scattered the Jewish people and He promised to bring them back – we are living when this long-awaited promise has come true.

If there was ever a time in history to know with clarity how to stand with the nation of Israel and the Jewish people worldwide, it is now. Since the unspeakable atrocities committed by Hamas terrorists against inhabitants in the south of Israel on October 7th, 2023, the nations have divided along the plumb line of whether they stand with Israel and the Jewish people or they do not. Pro-Palestinian demonstrations worldwide have been well attended, vocal, and vehemently militant. Hamas, and other Iranian backed terrorist organizations in the Middle East, have run a media campaign attempting to seduce the world into believing that there is a moral equivalency for what they call the 'illegal occupation" of Gaza and the "West Bank" and the demonic attack on October 7th by Hamas terrorists and some Gazan civilians.

If we know God's word, in some ways these events should not surprise us. After all, He does tell us that the ultimate judgment regarding the nations at the end of days will be their treatment of His people and their treatment of His land. Joel 3 is uncompromising: I will also gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat; And I will enter into judgment with them there on account of My people, My heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations; They have also divided up My land.

God begins this chapter of Joel telling us that **He will bring His people home from the ends of the earth and plant them in the land** (v.1) and ends by declaring His intention, oft repeated in His word, that He will cleanse them of their sin and bloodguilt and prosper them in the land where He Himself dwells (v.20-22). The implication in these words is that there will be nations who care for His people and nations who do not- the sheep and goat nations that Jesus referred to in Matthew 25:31-46.

And so, we pray for the faces of this war. We pray for the hostages of Hamas, the leaders of Israel, the leaders of Hamas, and the leaders of the nations who are choosing whether to bless or curse Israel.






Prayers for the Hostages

He reveals deep and hidden things; He knows what lies in darkness, and light dwells with him (Daniel 2:22 NIV).





Sapir (at left) was kidnapped together with her boyfriend, Alexander (Sasha) Trupanov, 28, (at left) and several family members from their home in Nir Oz. Sapir and Sasha moved to central Israel about a month before the brutal Hamas attack. On Oct. 7 they were visiting Sasha's family in Nir Oz.

When the attack began, the family hid together, but the terrorists broke into their home. The terrorists killed the father of the family, Vitaliy, and kidnapped Sapir, Sasha, his mother Yelena, and grandmother Tati.

Pray for the IDF to be united in thought, mind, and purpose.

Two are better than one because they have a good return for their labor: If either of them falls down, one can help the other up. But pity anyone who falls and has no one to help them up. Also, if two lie down together, they will keep warm. But how can one keep warm alone? Though one may be overpowered, two can defend themselves. A cord of three strands is not quickly broken (Ecclesiastes 4:9-12 NIV).

Pray for supernatural wisdom and divine strategy.

For the Lord gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly (Proverbs 2:6-8 NKJV).

For lack of guidance a nation falls, but victory is won through many advisers (Proverbs 11:14 NIV).



Israeli Citizens

Citizens in Israel are still living in a state of war. Pray for their mental and physical health.



Jewish People Worldwide

With outbursts of antisemitism blowing up worldwide, pray for protection of Jewish people wherever they live.

Prayer for the leaders of Hamas

IFA has confirmed acts of evil by Hamas fighters. Rape as a weapon of war. Dismembering innocent women and children. "My face is the last thing you will see," terrorists declare, before killing women they have brutalized. How can we pray for them? We can because the greatest victory against the enemy of our souls would be the salvation and transformation of these men. IFA's key verses inform us:

I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people—for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed to at the proper time (1 Tim. 2:1-4).

Miraculously, hundreds of Muslim men in Gaza dreamed about Christ on the same night. Lord, we know there is nothing too hard for you. Pray for the hearts of those who are willing to receive Jesus to turn to Him. In the hostage exchange, three Hamas militants were released by Israel for every 1 Israeli hostage. As former Congresswoman Michele Bachmann told IFA intercessors, Israel is one of the most humane military forces in the world. They warn civilians in military areas that an attack on Hamas is coming: "Who does this?," she asked. Let's pray that they will know Jesus and lay down their weapons of terror.

Pray for God to speak through dreams and visions.

In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falls on people as they slumber in their beds, he may speak in their ears and terrify them with warnings to turn them from wrongdoing and keep them from pride, to preserve them from the pit, their lives from perishing by the sword (Job 33:15-18 NIV).

Pray that secret council and strongholds would be supernaturally exposed in dreams or through prophetic revelation.

Now, the king of Aram was at war with Israel. After conferring with his officers, he said, "I will set up my camp in such and such a place." The man of God sent word to the king of Israel: "Beware of passing that place because the Arameans are going down there." So, the king of Israel checked on the place indicated by the man of God. Time and again, Elisha warned the king so that he was on his guard in such places. This enraged the king of Aram. He summoned his officers and demanded of them, "Tell me! Which of us is on the side of the king of Israel?" "None of us, my lord the king," said one of his officers, "but Elisha, the prophet who is in Israel, tells the king of Israel the very words you speak in your bedroom (2 Kings 6:9-12 NIV).

For those who remain indignant, ask for the Fear of the Lord to overtake them.

And the fear of God came on all the kingdoms of those countries when they heard that the Lord had fought against the enemies (2 Chronicles 20:29 AMP).

Pray that the plans of Hamas and those who support them would be thwarted.

Although they plot against you, their evil schemes will never succeed (Psalm 21:11 NLT).

Pray for confusion in the camp of Hamas and everywhere they conspire.

Lord, confuse the wicked, confound their words, for I see violence and strife in the city (Psalm 55:9).
