Rules of Engagement:

1. **By grace through faith** - revelation in our spirit and heart 2. BHAG: The only measure of relationship behavior towards one another is as unto the Lord.
 - When he/she becomes honoring/submits
3. **DIVORCE is not an option:** no Faith – no God involvement
 - **Only provision is for infidelity-** God will separate also if we take on other gods
4. **Love is a choice**
5. **Covenant is enforceable by God - not you**

“Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church. For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. “For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.” This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church. Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband.”

- We will be presenting our wives to the Lord - just as Paul will be presenting the church
- Your wife becomes your first ministry after ministry to God - as unto the Lord
- What state/what condition will your wife be in when you present her to the Lord?
- Nowhere in the Word does it say if your wife starts to honor me then I will treat her right.

Treatment - Behavior towards: heart condition

Malachi 2:13-16 ESV

“And this second thing you do. You cover the Lord’s altar with tears, with weeping and groaning because he no longer regards the offering or accepts it with favor from your hand. But you say, “Why does he not?” Because the Lord was witness between you and the wife of your youth, to whom you have been faithless, though she is your companion and your wife by covenant. Did he not make them one, with a portion of the Spirit in their union? And what was the one God seeking? Godly offspring. So guard yourselves in your spirit, and let none of you be faithless to the wife of your youth. “For the man who does not love his wife but divorces her, says the Lord, the God of Israel, covers his garment with violence, says the Lord of hosts. So guard yourselves in your spirit, and do not be faithless.””

- Faithless: bagad: offensive, unloving, harsh, deceitful
- Do we believe that marriage is important to God?
- He doesn’t accept anything from you if you treat your spouse faithlessly

Faithless and Opposite

Faithless. - Faithful

Offensive - Uplifting

Unloving. - Loving (great caring)

Harsh. - Gentle/tenderness

Deceitful - Honest

Acts of love: Outward Expression - Love your wives as Christ loved the church:

1. He left His throne - off your high place
2. Jesus said He came to serve not be served: He got under and washed our feet
3. Jesus shared His Father's Word - speak God's Word
4. Died for His bride = dying is easy. We die to ourselves daily
5. Jesus prayed for oneness (week 4) John 17:21
6. From a position of love, Jesus corrected, protected and directed and perfected
7. Covenant: riches, health, blessing
