SCRIPTURES AND CONFESSION FOR ISRAEL—THE LAND

Genesis 15:18 On the same day, the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying: To your descendants, I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates.

Genesis 17:8 Also, I give to you and your descendants after you the land in which you are a stranger, all the land of Canaan, as an everlasting possession; and I will be their God.

Joshua 1:4 From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your territory.

Jeremiah 30:3 For behold, the days are coming, says the Lord, that I will bring back from captivity My people Israel and Judah, says the Lord. And I will cause them to return to the land that I gave to their fathers, and they shall possess it.

Joel 2:21 Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice, for the Lord has done marvelous things!

Isaiah 27:6 Those who come He shall cause to take root in Jacob; Israel shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit.

Isaiah 35:1 The wilderness and the wasteland shall be glad for them, and the desert shall rejoice and blossom as the rose.

Joel 2:18 Then the Lord will be zealous for His land, and pity His people.

Isaiah 62:4 You shall no longer be termed Forsaken, nor shall your land any more be termed desolate; but you shall be called Hephzibah, My Delight is in Her, and your land Beulah, Married; for the Lord delights in you, and your land shall be married.

Joel 3:2 I will also gather all nations, and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat; And I will enter into judgment with them there on account of My people, My heritage Israel, whom they have scattered among the nations; they have also divided up My land.

Confession: *Father, we say that Israel shall have all the land within the biblical borders, and that she shall possess as an everlasting possession all the land from Lebanon to the river of Egypt and from the Great Sea to the River Euphrates. We thank You Father that the land of Israel is blossoming and filling the face of the world with fruit. We say that this land shall no longer be called Forsaken and Desolate, but it shall be a delight to the Lord for You delight in Your land, and it shall be married. We thank You Lord that You are doing marvelous things in this land because You are zealous for the land of Israel, and You will judge those who have divided Your land. Therefore Father, we pray and we say that the United States of America will always be on the right side of Israel and will abandon any and all plans to divide the land of Israel. We bless the land of Israel in the name of Yeshua Ha Meshiach!*

SCRIPTURES AND CONFESSION FOR ISRAEL—THE PEOPLE

Genesis 17:7 And I will establish My covenant between Me and you and your descendants after you in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to you and your descendants after you.

Psalms 125:2 As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the Lord surrounds His people from this time forth and forever.

Isaiah 41:14 Fear not, you worm Jacob, You men of Israel! I will help you, says the Lord and Your Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel.

Isaiah 51:15-16 But I am the Lord your God, Who divided the sea whose waves roared—The Lord of hosts is His name. And I have put My words in your mouth; I have covered you with the shadow of My hand, that I may plant the heavens, lay the foundations of the earth, and say to Zion, You are My people.

Isaiah 60:1-2, 20b-22 Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; but the Lord will arise over you, and His glory will be seen upon you. For the Lord will be your everlasting light, and the days of your mourning shall be ended. Also, your people shall all be righteous; they shall inherit the land forever, the branch of My planting, the work of My hands, that I may be glorified.

Isaiah 40:1 Comfort, yes, comfort My people, says your God.

Isaiah 61:6a-7 But you shall be named the priests of the Lord, they shall call you the servants of our God...Instead of your shame, you shall have double honor, and instead of confusion they shall rejoice in their portion. Therefore, in their land they shall possess double; everlasting joy shall be theirs.

Romans 11:26a And so all Israel will be saved...

Ezekiel 11:19-20 Then I will give them one heart, and I will put a new spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them a heart of flesh that they may walk in My statutes and keep My judgments and do them; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God.

Hosea 11:1a, 4 When Israel was a child, I loved him... I drew them with gentle cords, with bands of love, and I was to them as those who take the yoke from their neck. I stooped and fed them.

Romans 11:2a God has not cast away his people whom He foreknew.

Romans 11:28b-29 ...But concerning the election they are beloved for the sake of the fathers. For the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

Psalms 33:11 The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations.

Psalms 102:13 You will arise and have mercy on Zion; for the time to favor her, yes, the set time, has come.

Confession: *We thank You Father for Your plan for the people of Israel, and we say that that plan will stand to all generations. We say that You love Israel and that You arise and have mercy on the people of Israel. You take the yoke from their neck for the set time for their favor has come. We speak comfort to the people of Israel, and we say that the days of their mourning have ended and that as the mountains surround Jerusalem, You surround Your people forever. Instead of shame, they shall have double honor and they shall possess double in their land. We thank You Father that the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable and that You have not cast off Your people Israel. All Israel shall be saved because the Holy One of Israel is their Redeemer.*
