They [teenagers] will declare things – they will say things! They have such a hunger for more of Him, for His presence and allowing Him to do what He wants to do – freedom for Him to move.

Isaiah 44:3-5; (NKJV)

"For I will pour water on him who is thirsty, And floods on the dry ground; I will pour My Spirit on your descendants, And My blessing on your offspring; They will spring up among the grass Like willows by the watercourses. One will say, 'I am the LORD's'; Another will call himself by the name of Jacob; Another will write with his hand, 'The LORD's,' And name himself by the name of Israel."

This allows us to lay aside every sin and the weight that so easily besets us because of the hunger for God. Allowing the anointing of God, in just a moment, to break things from our life, and provide clear direction.

(Good News Translation) "One by one, people will say, 'I am the LORD's.' They will come to join the people of Israel. They each will mark the name of the LORD on their arms and call themselves one of God's people."

1 Timothy 4:12;

(KJV) "Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity."

(NLT) "Don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity."

God Used Young Adults in the Bible.

- David was fifteen years old when he killed Goliath. Then, he became King.
- Daniel was seventeen years old when he refused to eat the king's meat. He eventually became ruler over the province of Babylon and saw into the future, prophetically.
- Josiah was eight years old when he became king. He reigned in Jerusalem for thirty-one years. He did what was right in the eyes of the Lord and started a major revival.
- Jeremiah was seventeen years old when the Lord called him a prophet. The Lord told him, "Do not say, I am a youth. For you shall go to all to whom I send you, and whatever I command you, you shall speak."
- Jesus was thirty years old when he began His ministry. The disciples ranged from twenty-one to thirty-five. Many others followed him including children and teenagers. i.e.; a "young boy" had a vital part in multiplying the fish and loaves.

The History of Revival and Young People.

In every generation, God has been faithful to bring revival to His people and spiritual awakenings to the nations. In almost all cases, these movements of the Spirit were most evident among young people.

In 1858, Dwight L. Moody began a Sunday School for youth in a vacant tavern. It grew into a church filled with young believers. This became the launching pad for many great ministries in the 1800's.

One of the most striking characteristics of the Welsh Prayer Revival in 1859 was the effect it had on young people from age ten to fourteen. They would conduct prayer meetings and proved to be instrumental in bringing revival to villages. Most of the converts were young people. The Welsh Revival began when 26-year-old Evan Roberts told his college principal, "I keep hearing a voice that is telling me to go home and speak to our young people in my home church." The result was a sweeping revival in which 100,000 people were converted in five months throughout Wales.

Out of the "hippy" culture that arose among American youth in 1967 came a second counterculture called, "The Jesus Movement." Young people were baptized by the thousands. Many in their teens came to know Jesus as their Lord and savior, including a 19-year-old 'Pastor George' who eventually led his own parents to the Lord in August of 1975.

The counter to the woke movement is the awakening to God!

The story of Cape Cod in the <u>Hyannis community</u>. There was a silent presentation in one of the stores being showing in the 70's of the Jesus movement (revolution).

The "Jesus Revolution" was a Real Phenomenon.

The Jesus movement of the '60s and '70s started in California and quickly spread throughout the world. It sought to combine the 1960s counterculture and the "**Me decade**" attitude of the 1970s with evangelical Christianity. After years of rebellion against the establishment values of mainstream America, young hippies found something both comforting and refreshing about the **Jesus movement's rebranding of old-school Christianity**.
