The Devil's Strategy

Ephesians 6:10-11; (KJV)

*"Finally, my brethren, **be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might.** Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil."*

We all need an infusion of spiritual strength.

- I am strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.
- I am strong in faith, and I give glory to God.
- The Lord is the strength of my life.
- When I am weak, I say I am strong.

When I am strong, I am better equipped to help others.

*(AMPC) "In conclusion, be strong in the Lord [be empowered through your union with Him]; **draw your strength from Him** [that strength which His boundless might provide]. Put on God's whole armor [the armor of a heavy-armed soldier which God supplies], **that you may be able to successfully stand up against [all] the strategies and the deceits of the devil.**"*

One key strategy of the devil is called, "**The Pile-On Technique.**"

He piles one situation on top of the other, often leaving people overwhelmed and overloaded. This method is designed to have you back away from the Word of God, have less confessions (declarations) of faith, and reach the point where you even give up on your faith. Once that happens, the devil has succeeded in stealing the Word from you.

“Somebody Help Me!”

Many people are experiencing constant demands, expectations, obligations, and responsibilities of family, work, school, children, church, and community. They try to balance their personal lives with endless to-do-lists. Add to that the serious prophetic end times we are living in.

Daniel 12:4; (KJV)

“But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall rush to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.”

(NLT) “Many shall rush here and there.”

(MSG) “There is going to be a lot of frantic running around trying to figure out what is going on.”

There are adjustments that we make in these end time days, and the greatest adjustment is ensuring the Word remains first place in our life.

As Pastor, when I am praying, I ‘hear’ some of your voices crying out:

- “I have more to do than I can handle.”
- “I could work 24 hours a day for a week and still not catch up.”

When Your Heart is Overwhelmed

Psalms 61:1-4; (KJV)

*“Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer. From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, **when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I.** For thou hast been a shelter for me, and a strong tower from the enemy. I will abide in thy tabernacle for ever: I will trust in the covert of thy wings.”*

When your heart is overwhelmed, what do you do - run to the rock!

Getting control over our lives doesn't start with our day timer. **It begins by discovering what the Word says about bringing God's divine order into our lives.**

Psalm 62:5-8 (KJV)

"My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him. He only is my rock and my salvation: He is my defense; I shall not be moved. In God is my salvation and my glory: the rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God. Trust in Him at all times; ye people, pour out your heart before Him: God is a refuge for us. Selah."

Pastor George shared that he prays in tongues a lot; praying out the mysteries of God. As an example, Pastor shared after he prayed this morning for today's service, he prayed another thirty minutes in the spirit to sharpen his senses and to uncover areas where people have been overwhelmed. Bringing him to the place where he could receive God's plan and direction for this service.

[Praise God for such a Pastor!]

The God of Divine Order

1 Corinthians 14:33; (KJV)

"For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints."

Confusion and exhaustion do not come from God!

*(AMPC) "He... is not a God of confusion and disorder but of **peace and order.**"*

Our God is **THE originator of Divine Order.**

Genesis 1:1-3; (KJV)

*"In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was **without form, and void**; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light."*

"Without form and void" in the Hebrew means: An out-of-control, overwhelming, extremely confusing, or disorderly situation; pandemonium.

Billye Brim describes it as many teenager's school lockers, out-of-control. Or perhaps a better example is your garage – the disorder.

God brings divine order to the universe; therefore, He can bring divine order to our lives.

There are times you need to believe for extra time so that you don't wear out. The devil's strategy is to keep you so busy to have you wear out, burn out, and vision out where your direction, strength and help are depleted.

We Have THE Helper - this is our advantage.

John 14:26-27; (KJV)

The comforter in the Greek is the one called alongside to aid.

(AMPC) "But the Comforter (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengtheners, Standby), the Holy Spirit, Whom the Father will send in My name [in My place, to represent Me and act on My behalf], He will teach you all things. And He will cause you to recall (will remind you of, bring to your remembrance) everything I have told you."

- The Holy Spirit will help us prioritize, organize, and simplify our lives because He is the **"Master Efficiency Expert."**
- I have **"Supernatural Acceleration"** when I am obeying the leading of the Holy Spirit.
- **"Running to the Rock"** means I am asking the Father, "What do I do about this? Reveal your plan to me..."
- **Time in the Spirit** is so different than time in the natural. You can have time added to things in the natural, because of time you spent in the Spirit.

Proverbs 3:5-6; (AMPC)

*“Lean on, trust in, and be confident in the Lord with all your heart and mind and do not rely on your own insight or understanding. In all your ways know, recognize, and acknowledge Him, and **He will direct and make straight and plain your paths.**”*

Psalm 37:23: (NKJV)

“The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, And He delights in his way.”

Psalm 31:15; (AMPC)

“My times are in your hands.”

Mark 11:22-23; (KJV)

“To your mountain.”

Speak to your life, talk to situations in your life, the mountain of laundry, the mountain of items to do, the mountain of things scheduled.

Speak to these things and say; *“You will not overwhelm me!”*

Receive the wisdom and the peace of God. Talk to them, this is talking to your life. Your words of faith are powerfully.

Matthew 11:28-30; (AMPC)

“Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy-laden and overburdened, and I will cause you to rest. [I will ease and relieve and refresh your souls.] Take My yoke upon you and learn of Me, for I am gentle (meek) and humble (lowly) in heart, and you will find rest (relief and ease and refreshment and recreation and blessed quiet) for your souls. For My yoke is wholesome (useful, good—not harsh, hard, sharp, or pressing, but comfortable, gracious, and pleasant), and My burden is light and easy to be borne.”

Ask the Lord for a vacation, ...For the finances, ...for sound rest so that you are no longer up all night.

Because the Lord orders my steps
and my times are in His hands,
I receive all the time I need
to do everything I need to do,
with much time left over.
