*Mark 4:14-15; (KJV)*

*“The sower soweth the word. And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, **Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts.**”*

We are not ignorant of satan's devices or the thoughts that he thinks.

Some receive a touch from God and are healed. They return home and the condition tries to return. They may say; *“I guess I never received my healing in the first place.”* This is not true, as it is God's desire to always heal.

## Post "MIRACLES ON THE MOUNTAIN" Instructions

### I Resist the Devil

*James 4:7; (KJV)*

*"Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you."*

(MSG) "So let God work His will in you. Yell a loud "no" to the Devil and watch him make himself scarce. Say a quiet "yes" to God and He'll be there in no time."

*Say; "No Satan! I resist you in the Name of Jesus. I refuse to take back that sickness. It is not mine. It doesn't belong to me. Christ redeemed me from the curse of sickness, disease, and infirmity. I am walking in perfect health and wholeness. I am healed NOW and I'm NOT going back!"*

Many believers aren't missing their healing because of their believing. They are missing it in resisting the devil. Resisting is simply standing your ground, being obstinate in what you know is correct and yours. "Bulldog faith" bites down on what is yours and won't let it go!

*Ephesians 4:27; (NIV)*

*"And do not give the devil a foothold."*

We continue to resist the devil, and everything associated with him. That includes symptoms, lies, fear, and pressure.

### I Hold Fast

Many believers think that once they receive their healing, there is nothing left to do. As a result, many lose their healing on a counterattack.

*1 Thessalonians 5:21; (KJV)*

*“...**HOLD FAST** that which is good.”*

Healing is always a good thing!

*Ephesians 6:10(KJV)*

*“Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.”*

Might = in God's ability.

*V.14 (AMPC) “Stand therefore by holding your ground.”*

Speak to yourself each day that you are becoming stronger and wealthier – faith combined with patience, and walked it out in love brings progression and growth! Encourage yourself just like David did.

*Revelation 3:11; (KJV)*

*“...**HOLD THAT FAST** which thou hast, that no man takes thy crown.”*

The devil will try to take what I've received, or else I wouldn't need to hold on to it. The devil is defeated, and we are called to exercise his defeat.

### **What Do I Hold Fast to? I Hold Fast to Words of Life**

*Psalms 107:20; (KJV)*

*“He sent His word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.”*

Proverbs 4:20-27; (KJV)

*“My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings.*

*21 Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart.*

*22 For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh.*

*23 Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life.*

*24 Put away from thee a froward mouth, and **perverse lips** put far from thee.*

*25 Let thine eyes look right on, and let thine eyelids look straight before thee.*

*26 Ponder the path of thy feet, and let all thy ways be established.*

*27 Turn not to the right hand nor to the left: remove thy foot from evil.”*

Perverse lips = This is saying statements like; “I guess I’m sick,” or “I don’t have the money for that because I’m broke.” Speak the word only.

Hebrews 4:12; (AMPC)

*“For the Word that God speaks is alive and full of power [making it active, operative, energizing, and effective].”*

Matthew 4:4; (KJV)

*“But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.”*

## **I Hold Fast to My Confession of Faith**

*Hebrews 10:23; (KJV)*

*“Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for He is faithful that promised;).”*

*Proverbs 18:21; (KJV)*

*“Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.”*

You can turn things around with your words. As life and death are in the power of the tongue

*Matthew 12:37; (KJV)*

*“For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.”*

*Matthew 12:37; (Pastor George Translation)*

*“By your words you are healed, and by your words you are sick.”*

*James 3:2-3; (KJV) [James is referring to his half-brother, Jesus]*

*“For in many things we offend all. If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man, and able also to bridle the whole body.*

*<sup>3</sup>Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we turn about their whole body.”*

Our words will turn the situation around just as a simple small bit can turn the direction of a massive horse.

We hold on to the Word and don't let go just as we would hold onto the straps when water tubing on a lake.



I repetitively say what God's Word says about my healing regardless of what thoughts the enemy may tell my mind, or what symptoms I may be dealing with.

### **I Hold Fast to Sound Words of Teaching**

*2 Timothy 1:13-14; (AMPC)*

*“Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. That good thing which was committed unto thee keep by the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us.”*

*Romans 10:17;*

*“So then faith (for healing) cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of (healing) God.”*

Immerse yourself in messages about healing.

### **I Refuse to Fear**

*Psalm 34:4; (KJV)*

Fear keeps the door open to sickness. Don't entertain the thought of what will happen when this comes back.

*Job 3:25;*

*“For the thing which I greatly feared is come upon me, and that which I was afraid of is come unto me.”*

Hebrews meaning = I feared a fear and it came upon me.

Psalm 34:4; (AMPC)

*“I sought (inquired of) the Lord and required Him [of necessity and on the authority of His Word], and He heard me, and delivered me from all my fears.”*

2 Timothy 1:7; (KJV)

*“For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.”*

Nahum 1:9; (KJV)

*“Affliction shall **NOT** rise a second time!”*

### **After the Healing**

When the New Covenant records the healings of individuals, many times it reveals what they did after they were healed.

Acts 3:8; (KJV)

*“And he leaping up stood, and walked, and **entered with them into the temple**, walking, and leaping, and praising God.”*

John 5:14; (NLT)

*“But afterward Jesus found him (the man healed at the Pool of Bethesda) **in the Temple** and told him, ‘Now you are well; so **stop sinning**, or something even worse may happen to you.’”*

Luke 17:14; (NLT)



“He looked at them and said, **“Go show yourselves to the priests.”** And as they went, they were cleansed of their leprosy.”

We draw spiritual strength to stay healed when we are connected to a healing believing church.

Psalm 92:12-15; (AMPC)

“The [uncompromisingly] righteous shall flourish like the palm tree [be long-lived, stately, upright, useful, and fruitful]; they shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon [majestic, stable, durable, and incorruptible]. Planted in the house of the Lord, they shall flourish in the courts of our God. [Growing in grace] they shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be full of sap [of spiritual vitality] and [rich in the] verdure [of trust, love, and contentment]. [They are living memorials] to show that the Lord is upright and faithful to His promises; He is my Rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him.”

Verdure: The greenness of growing, referring to healthy growth.
