

Victory Over Lack

Pastor George's Offering Message

Jeremiah 23:4 (KJV)

"And I will set up shepherds over them which shall feed them: and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, neither shall they be lacking, saith the LORD."

It is the responsibility of a Pastor to teach their congregation the laws that govern supernatural abundance and prosperity, allowing them to overcome lack and to prosper, regardless of the economic times.

Recently, while in prayer, I heard the Spirit of God shout this to me on the inside. It is a word for EMIC: **"VICTORY OVER LACK!"**

Lack means:

- To fall short, come behind, and be in a state of deficient.
- To barely survive in a state of not having enough.
- Lack is a part of the curse of the law.

Deuteronomy 28:38-40, 42-44; (NLT)

"You will plant much but harvest little, for locusts will eat your crops. You will plant vineyards and care for them, but you will not drink the wine or eat the grapes, for worms will destroy the vines. You will grow olive trees throughout your land, but you will never use the olive oil, for the fruit will drop before it ripens.

Swarms of insects will destroy your trees and crops. The foreigners living among you will become stronger and stronger, while you become weaker

and weaker. They will lend money to you, but you will not lend to them. They will be the head, and you will be the tail!"

Jesus has delivered us from the curse of lack!

Galatians 3:13-14; (NKJV)

"Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith."

Let's look at THE BLESSING!

Deuteronomy 28:8, 11; (NKJV)

"The LORD will command the blessing on you in your STOREHOUSES and in all to which you set your hand, and He will bless you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you.

And the Lord shall make you have a SURPLUS OF PROSPERITY!"

When we believe God, stand on His Word, give, and tithe in faith — we will NOT lack, fall short, come behind, or be destitute.

Victory Over Lack Scriptures:

Deuteronomy 2:7; (NLT)

"For the LORD your God has blessed you in everything you have done. He has watched your every step through this great wilderness. During these forty years, the LORD your God has been with you, and you have lacked nothing.

Luke 22:35; (GW)

"Then Jesus said to them, 'When I sent you out without a wallet, traveling bag, or sandals, you didn't lack anything, did you?' 'Not a thing!' They answered."

James 1:2-4; (NKJV)

"My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing."

(TMT says, "Not deficient in any way.")

Psalms 34:10; (AMPC)

"The young lions lack food and suffer hunger, but they who seek (inquire of and require) the Lord [by right of their need and on the authority of His Word], none of them shall lack any beneficial thing."

2 Corinthians 9:8; (AMPC)

"And God is able to make all grace (every favor and earthly blessing) come to you in abundance, so that you may always and under all circumstances and whatever the need be self-sufficient [possessing enough to require no aid or support and FURNISHED IN ABUNDANCE for EVERY good work and charitable donation]."

(The RSV Translation says, "You may always have enough of everything.")

- I am redeemed from the curse of lack.
- The LORD supplies all my needs.
- I have enough money and resources to do everything I need to do, with much left over.
- I have no lack — only abundance.

- I attack lack with my declaration of faith.
- Therefore, I have VICTORY OVER LACK!"
