Be Available: We never pass up an opportunity to have an impact. Never underestimate a moment with a student. We are always willing to make our tasks or plans secondary to the purpose of demonstrating the Love and Faith of our heavenly Father.

Be Safe: We provide safety to all three areas of a student (spirit, soul, body). This is accomplished in four ways:

- 1) When ministering to a student we always start with the Word of God and our sole purpose is to show and demonstrate the character of Jesus Christ.
- 2) We never put ourselves in one-on-one situations with a student. Always follow the two-deep rule with another team member.
- 3) We ensure that all 14forty locations are clean, secure, and ready to welcome students for every service.
- 4) We are aware of people who are not students or staff in the ballroom. All adult visitors should enter or exit through the adult doors & remain in the designated area. All visitors should be wearing an approved wristband or badge.

Be A Guide: Our speech, actions and purpose always demonstrate the place that Jesus has both in us as individuals and as a youth ministry. We help guide students through their teenage years by being living examples of what a life of Faith and Love in Jesus sounds, acts and looks like, even if it is just for a week.

Be Excited: As a team we are so excited about the call and purpose of 14forty. But we never want to assume that our excitement is understood. Remember that at any given time at least 5-7 students are looking at you! Students will match whatever level of excitement we demonstrate but they will never exceed what we show them. We always maintain a high level of excitement and enthusiasm for what God is doing.
