Come Ready To:

- Minister love and joy to those around; prepare for each service you will be serving in.
- Maintain a good attitude: be attentive, proactive, and positive!
- Stay in your position once assigned- you were placed in an area for a specific purpose.
- Be aware of people who are not students or staff:
 - ALL visitors should have a badge or an approved wristband. Direct those out of place to sign in and obtain a wristband. Those with a badge or wristband may sit in the designated visitor section.

Dress Code:

- Wear required badge & comfortable shoes.
- Wear clothing that is appropriate, modest & neat as you are a representative of Jesus, Student Ministries & KCM.
- What you should **NOT** wear:
 - Ladies- no low cut tops, short skirts or shorts
 - Gentlemen- no earrings or other facial piercings may be worn (KCM Policy)

General Info:

- Please turn phone on silent while serving and refrain from using during services.
- Make sure you sign in and out with your lead each time you arrive and leave. (All volunteers receive a convention media set after serving 8 or more times!)
- Make a commitment to be on time! If you are late to a report time, you may be unable to volunteer for that service.
- REMEMBER: You represent 14forty and KCM off site as well! Be kind to hotel staff, convention guests and any individuals you contact during the week. You will be recognized. 😊
