Call Down Mount Corruption

A. Exodus 19:3, 14—The Role of the Pastor

1. Verses 3,14 (NKJV) “And Moses went up to God, and the LORD called to him from the mountain, saying, ‘Thus you shall say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel....’ So Moses went down from the mountain to the people and sanctified the people, and they washed their clothes.”
2. I have been going up the mountain every Saturday since 1993, hearing from God and coming back down the mountain with a message for the congregation on Sunday.
3. “Lord, what do You want to say and what do You want to do?”
4. I have preached on many subjects — including politics.
5. Why? Because it’s my responsibility to educate and inform my congregation about decisions made by elected officials and how those decisions relate to the Bible says.

B. “Preach on the Political Party Platforms”

1. I received a life-long assignment from Kenneth Copeland on September 22, 2012, in light of that year’s upcoming presidential election.
2. “George, you need to take the two political platforms and preach on those points.
 - a. Look at what the two parties say about particular issues.
 - b. Compare the two platforms to God’s Word.
 - c. Determine which platform best aligns with how the Kingdom of God operates.”
3. “Make it really clear that a platform is something you stand on.
 - a. The platform planks represent the individual issues.
 - b. You are standing on the whole stage.”
4. “To vote for that platform is to attach yourself to it and partake of the judgement of that platform.”
5. “You could vote for that person for some other reason, but if they are an abortionist, you are an accomplice.
 - a. There is no way out of it.
 - b. Just because you did it for some other reason doesn’t get you off the hook.”

C. Some Say, “Nobody Pays Attention to the Platforms”

1. First of all, God knows what is on those platforms.
 - a. He has read them.
 - b. He will hold us accountable to them.
2. Secondly, they were written by, “We the People.”
 - a. They are representatives from every state in the Union.
 - b. From the abundance of their hearts, the parties speak.
3. Thirdly, politicians will make their decisions on our behalf based upon the platform they embrace and stand on.
 - a. The platform is the driving agenda for all legislation.
 - b. It is what they are going to push to accomplish over the next four years — and beyond.
4. “Tell my people wherever you go — those who vote for politicians knowing their immoral policies and platforms and illegal acts had better repent. They are partners with those politicians and will be responsible for every baby’s death. You have taken the devil’s part by not voting at all.”

5. “I will,” saith the Lord, “hold you responsible for voting for whom I tell you to vote. And you can’t get out of it by not voting. I’ll hold you responsible for voting for the wrong one if you do that. Some are saying they just won’t vote. Actually, you just did. You are still an accomplice because you knew about a crime and you did nothing to stop it.” — Kenneth Copeland

E. I Asked the Same Question of the Lord in Regard to My Assignment Today

1. What do You want to say to us?
2. The direction literally dropped down into my heart the very moment I asked.
3. He gave me the scriptures and a revelation I had never thought of before.
4. He told me how to finish the message.

5. He said, “Take authority over corruption.”
 - a. Last November’s election was stolen.
 - b. The wrong man is in office.
 - c. That is why there is no anointing.
 - d. Release corporate faith and shut this down.

F. Genesis 1:26-28—The Authority of the Believer

1. Verses 26-28 “And God said, Let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them. And God blessed them, and God said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth, and subdue it: and have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the fowl of the air, and over every living thing that moveth upon the earth.”
2. Verse 26 (AMPC) “...let them have complete authority...”
3. Subdue = If it gets out of line, put it back.

G. Mark 11:22-24—Call Down Mount Corruption

1. Verses 22-24 “And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto THIS MOUNTAIN, Be thou REMOVED, and be thou CAST into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.”
2. There are seven mountains on which Jerusalem rests.
 - a. There is one called “the hill that is before Jerusalem.”
 - b. It is also called, “The Mount of Corruption.”
3. The Mount of Corruption is where King Solomon built altars to pagan gods in order to appease his many foreign wives. Scripture also seems to indicate that Solomon himself, in his old age, also indulged in worshipping pagan deities.
4. King Josiah was the last righteous ruler the Kingdom of Judah enjoyed before being destroyed by the Babylonians. During his reign, he destroyed the pagan altars erected by Solomon on Mount Corruption and defied the area he used so that all idolatrous practices within would cease.
5. 2 Kings 23:13-14 (NIV) “The King also desecrated the high places that were east of Jerusalem on the south of the Hill of Corruption – the ones Solomon king of Israel had built for Ashtoreth the vile goddess of the Sidonians, for Chemosh the vile god of Moab, and for Molek the detestable god of the people of Ammon. Josiah smashed the sacred stones and cut down the Asherah poles and covered the sites with human bones.”

6. Could it be that Jesus was pointing to the Mount of Corruption in Mark 11:23 when He said, “Be thou removed and be cast into the sea?”
7. Isaiah 41:15-16 “Behold, I will make thee a new sharp threshing instrument having teeth: thou shalt thresh the mountains, and beat them small, and shalt make the hills as chaff. Thou shalt fan them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them: and thou shalt rejoice in the Lord, and shalt glory in the Holy One of Israel.”

H. Call Down Mount Corruption

In the Name which is above every name.
